HIGHLIGHTS OF POLAND - May 14 - 18, 2007, 5 days

TOUR COST - \$760 double room, Single room supplement. \$295

Round trip flight are available.

14 May/Mon - WARSAW/KRAKOW. Meet your guide and other tour participants at 9:00 AM in the hotel lobby and depart for city tour of Warsaw. Start at the colorful Old Town rebuilt with great reverence after WWII. Walk through the cobble stone street to the St.John's Cathedral and picturesque Royal Castle Square. Then, drive along the Royal Route to the Lazienki Park built by last king of Poland in the 18th century. After lunch depart for the medieval city of Krakow. (B,L)

15 May/Tue - KRAKOW-Wieliczka. This morning tour of the charming city of Krakow includes Wawel Coronation Cathedral, Old Town Square and St. Mary's Church with famous Gothic altar. Enjoy a stroll along the shops of the Cloth Hall filled with souvenir shops where you can buy amber, crystal, folk art handicrafts. In the afternoon depart for Wieliczka salt mines, the oldest in Europe. On a 1.5-mile tourist route discover fantastic underground world of salt grottoes, sculptures, chapels and even a sanatorium of asthma patients. (B, L)

16 May/Wed - KRAKOW-Auschwitz, Wadowice. After breakfast depart for Auschwitz, former Nazi concentration camp, now a martyrdom museum. Return to Krakow via Wadowice, birthplace of Pope John Paul II. Balance of day at leisure. Dinner at the local restaurant. (B,L)

17 May/Thu - KRAKOW/WARSAW. This morning your motor coach returns to Warsaw. Balance of day at leisure. Farewell dinner. (B, D)

18 May/Fri - WARSAW. After breakfast, termination of services. (B)

If you wish to extend your stay in Southern Poland and fly home from Krakow, deduct \$35 per person.

May 14/Mon - WARSAW. Morning at leisure. Meet the tour participants at 6:00 pm in the hotel lobby to depart for a welcome dinner. (D)

May 15/Tue - WARSAW. Highlights of your tour include Old Town rebuilt with great reverence after WWII. Continue to Jewish Memorial. Then, drive along the Royal Route to the Lazienki Park. Included is a visit to the Royal Castle, last residence of the Polish Kings. Balance of day free. In the evening Chopin recital. (B,L)

May 16/Wed - WARSAW/Czestochowa/ZAKOPANE. This morning depart for Czestochowa, pilgrimage center of Poland. Here you will tour the Jasna Gora Monastery and the shrine of the Black Madonna. After lunch continue to the resort of Zakopane. (B,L)

May 17/Thu - ZAKOPANE. After breakfast sightseeing tour of Zakopane. Admire the breathtaking views of the Tatras from the top of Gubalowka Mountain. In the afternoon free time to shop for local arts and crafts. Enjoy dinner with a folk band. (B,D)

May 18/Fri - ZAKOPANE/KRAKOW. Today you will enjoy a raft ride on the Dunajec River at the Pieniny National Park. After lunch depart for Krakow. (B,L)

May 19/Sat - KRAKOW-Wieliczka. Morning sightseeing tour of Krakow includes: the Wawel Royal Castle, Old Market Square, Cloth Hall and St. Mary's Church. After lunch, excursion to Wieliczka Salt Mine, existing more than 700 years. Balance of day at leisure. Dinner at the local restaurant. (B,D)

May 20/Sun - KRAKOW/Auschwitz/Wadowice. After breakfast depart for Auschwitz, former Nazi concentration camp, now a martyrdom museum. Return to Krakow via Wadowice, birthplace of Pope John Paul II. (B,D)

May 21/Mon - KRAKOW/WARSAW. This morning return to Warsaw. Balance of day at leisure. Farewell dinner with a folklore show. (B,D)

May 22/Tue - WARSAW. After breakfast, termination of tour services. (B)

May 14/Mon - WARSAW. Day at leisure. Meet the tour participants at 6:00 pm in the hotel lobby. Welcome dinner with folklore show. (D)

May 15/Tue - WARSAW. Highlights of your half-day tour include Old Town, rebuilt with great care after WW II, with its beautiful Market Square, the Barbican, St. John's Cathedral. Continue to Jewish Memorial and along the Royal Route to Lazienki Park. Afternoon, visit the Royal Castle, former residence of Polish kings. Balance of day free. In the evening enjoy a Chopin recital. (B,L)

May 16/Wed - WARSAW/Czestochowa/Auschwitz/ZAKOPANE. After breakfast, depart South for the Tatra Mountains. En route, stop in Czestochowa to tour the Jasna Gora Monastery with the Black Madonna Shrine. Then on to Auschwitz, former Nazi concentration camp, now a martyrdom museum. After lunch continue to Zakopane for overnight in beautiful mountain resort. (B,L)

May 17/Thu - ZAKOPANE/KRAKOW. Start the day with a sightseeing tour of Zakopane. Admire the breathtaking views of the Tatras from the top of Gubalowka Mountain. In the afternoon take a relaxing raft trip down the Dunajec River in the National Park. Continue to Krakow for dinner and overnight. (B,D)

May 18/Fri - KRAKOW-Wieliczka. This morning tour of the charming city of Krakow includes Wawel Hill, Old Town Square and St. Mary's Church. Enjoy a stroll through the souvenir shops of the Cloth Hall. Afternoon, depart for Wieliczka Salt Mine, with underground wonders carved from salt. Dinner with folklore show at a local restaurant. (B,D)

May 19/Sat - KRAKOW/WARSAW. This morning, your motorcoach returns to Warsaw Dinner on your own. (B,L)

May 20/Sun - WARSAW. After breakfast, termination of the tour services. (B)

TOUR CONDITIONS

ABOUT POLAND

POLAND is situated in a very central part of Europe and covers an area of 121,733 square miles - comparable to that of the state of New Mexico. It is the seventh largest country in Europe with population of about 40 million.

CLIMATE: Poland is situated in a zone of moderate climate with a considerable influence of sea climate along the Baltic seacoast belt. The climate resembles that of New England. Normal seasonal clothing is adequate but a warmer garment should be included. Comfortable shoes are a must. Hotels offer laundry service except on Sundays and Holidays.

CURRENCY: There is no limit to the amount of foreign currency that may be brought into the country. Polish monetary unit is ZLOTY divided into 100 groszy.

It is suggested you take mostly cash as travelers checks are not accepted in currency exchange places called "KANTOR" where you will be changing your money.

ATM machines are available in tourist areas.

ELECTRICITY: 220v/50 cycles. All-purpose transformer and 2-prong adapter is required for U.S. appliances.

TIME: Six hours ahead of U.S. Eastern Daylight Time. The 24-hour clock is used.

CREDIT CARDS: AX, Diners Club, VISA, Master Charge credit cards are accepted in major shops, restaurants, hotels and nightclubs. Discover card is not accepted. Also AX is not widely used.

TIPPING: Not obligatory, but appreciated. Cab drivers and waiters accept between 10-15%. There is also a nominal charge for use of cloak rooms and public rest rooms.

On tour, recommended tipping is \$2.50 per person for the tour guide and \$1.50 per person for the motorcoach driver.

RESERVATIONS/PAYMENTS: A deposit of \$200 per person payable by check or a major credit card is required at the time of booking. Full payment is due APRIL 2, 2007 days before departure.

Every effort will be made to find the lowest available fare for the air transportation to Warsaw from your home town. Many airlines fly to Warsaw. Only LOT Polish Airlines provide non-stop service from Chicago, Newark and JFK to Warsaw.

TOUR COST: Tour price is based on currency exchange levels in effect at the time of printing. It is subject to adjustment in the event of significant changes in the exchange levels.

Every effort will be made to provide flight reservations for the lowest available fares in effect at the time of booking.

Hotel accommodations will be provided in twin bedded rooms with private bath. Single rooms are available at the supplement shown. While every effort will be made to provide sharing of accommodations for persons booking alone, when requested, it cannot be guaranteed and single supplement must be paid before departure when billed. Triple rooms are not available.

Unused hotel accommodations or any other unused features of this tour are not refundable or exchangeable for other services. The right is reserved to substitute hotels and sightseeing features if it becomes necessary.

NOT INCLUDED IN THE TOUR COST: Cost of passports, baggage handling, items of a personal nature; phone calls, laundry, optional insurance, additional meals/beverages, gratuities to escorts, local guides and drivers.

BAGGAGE: Porterage of one suitcase per person is included in the tour cost not exceeding 50 lbs. Limit on carry-on bag is 13 lbs. It is advisable to pack a folding bag for purchases you make abroad.

NO VACCINATIONS are required by law.

DOCUMENTS: A valid U.S. or foreign passport is required. To apply for passport, contact your local Post Office. Check the validity of your passport. Passport should be valid for at least three months after your return date.

CANCELLATIONS: All cancellations must be made in writing to PAT TOURS. Full refund will be made for cancellations received up to 45 days prior to departure less a \$25 administrative fee. Between 45 - 36 days deposit of \$200 is non-refundable. No refund will be made for cancellations received less than 35 days prior to departure. *After the airline ticket is issued, airfare is refundable in case of hospitalization, otherwise \$200 per ticket is forfeited.* After completion of the tour, claims for refund must be made in writing within 30 days.

INSURANCE: All-inclusive insurance (cancellation, accident/health, baggage, delays) is strongly recommended and will be offered to all tour participants with confirmation. *If you have a pre-existing condition, insurance must be purchased within 7 days of deposit. Call PAT TOURS to request insurance application.* Insurance premium is non-refundable once purchased.
